

Outdoor Ice Skating Rink

Celebrate the holiday season by skating on the Morehead City Waterfront. The Morehead City Parks & Recreation Department will be operating an artificial ice skating rink from Friday, December 6 – Wednesday, January 1 (closed on 12/24 & 25). Skating fees are \$5.00 per skater (fee includes rental skates) for each 45-minute skating session. Skating sessions are limited to 40 skaters per session. For groups ticket sales, please contact the MCPRD at 726-5083. All participants or parents/guardians of minor participants must read and sign a release waiver to skate.
